

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS?????

Can I go scuba diving if I am not certified ?

YES! We offer an INTRODUCTORY DIVE for first timers! Entry is easy & fun!

Can I go scuba diving to MOLOKINI if I am not certified?

NO! The State of Hawaii has ruled that only certified divers are allowed to scuba dive at MOLOKINI. The depths range from 60'-150"+ and it is unsafe to let non-certified divers go diving there. It is also against the law!

Can I get certified in as little as two days?

YES! We offer both the SCUBA DIVER and OPEN WATER CERTIFICATION which can be completed in as little as two days. See: "SCUBA CLASSES".

Can I go above 2,000' after scuba diving if I wait at least 12 hours ?

YES. If your total bottom time is under two hours, the minimum wait time to go above 2000' is 12 hours! Especially so if you only did a shore dive in the shallows!

Do the rules about " flying after diving" apply to both SCUBA and SNUBA ?

YES! According to Divers Alert Network (DAN) the rules apply to both SCUBA and SNUBA. The doctors on staff at DAN specialize in " dive medicine ".

Do I need a doctor's release to go SCUBA DIVING and to do SNUBA ?

NO as long as you do not have any "YES" answers on the Medical Questionnaire. This questionnaire is the standard in the industry ! See " Medical Questionnaire".

Can I go scuba diving or do snuba if I am pregnant?

NO!

Do I need to be certified to use the Underwater Scooters?

YES! However, if you complete our "SCUBA DIVER CERTIFICATION" you can!

Do I need to drive to your shop to pick up my gear before diving with SCUBA LUV?

NO! All gear is on premises! Check in at the beach ! Your family is welcome too!

Where is the best place to dive on MAUI?

Daily dive locations are based on weather conditions and diving ability of the individual! Maui has many great dive sites for all levels of divers! Generally, the least amount of divers in the water, the more fish you will see! It just makes sense! Check with our RESERVATIONS DEPARTMENT for a daily update on conditions!
