COMMERSON’S FROGFISH SOUTH MAUI

Also known as “GIANT FROGFISH”, this is the most common and largest frogfish in Hawaii. They can be brown, black, red, orange, pink, white, green, mottled or yellow. Juveniles are always bright yellow, mimicking the yellow sponge they can often be found on or near.

They are territorial and can remain in the same area for years. They sport an appendage on the top of their head that they wave back and forth like a lure. Though they perch motionless in wait of prey, their strike is lightning FAST! They can grow up to 10”!
