"UPSIDE DOWN JELLY FISH"



These unusual jellyfish rest on the bottom, upside down, arms up. The bushy, many branched arms obscure the bell, which pulses continually to convey food upward. Symbiotic algae living in the arms contribute sugars to the food supply and impart the brownish coloration.

These animals have a mild sting if disturbed.

We found this guy free swimming which is quite rare.
